

John Guyer II his wife Abigal lived in Charles, North Carolina where they raised nine children.

Three of their sons, Jesse, Aaron, & Exum moved to Crawford County in 1813. This was only one year after the massacre of Isaac Hutson's family in 1812 and four years before Crawford officially became a county in 1816. At the time, Crawford County encompassed about 1/3 of Illinois, In 1831 it was reduced to its current size.

Jesse Guyer's lienage came to an end when Robert Jesse Baliff, the last of his descendants, died in 1924, but many descendants of Aaron & Exum still live in the area to this day
